





Life@Kalinga



Our faculty




Cafeteria

Industry Integrated programs

Industry Integration

Industry Integration is a process of integrating academic curriculum of a course with the Industry requirements in such a way that the end product becomes a useful input for the Industry. Industry Integration is the unique aspect of these programmes which not only differentiates our programmes from all other but is beneficial to student as well as the industry. This concept is different from traditional management education.

To understand Integration let us understand the TRADITIONAL Management qualification .

In traditional management qualification at under graduate or post graduate level the typical set up would consist of a regular college having infrastructure & facilities. There will be class room teaching as per the curriculum, regular test, personality development & other facilities.

What is lacking in a traditional setup is limited industry interface of only two months summer training in an industry and hence once the student passes out from the college & joins an industry he has almost nil or limited industry experience , he learns on the job and while learning on the job he struggles to understand organization , procedures, application of known management concepts & then looks forward to growth after 2 to 3 years.

On the other hand Industry has to deal with a fresh recruit who has no knowledge about the industry apart from what he has learnt In the text books.In the absence of structured induction & training department & everyone busy with his / her job it takes a much longer time to train a person ,make him comfortable & start getting output from him/her.

On the contrary in Industry Integrated education system where a student after learning basic management concepts takes up training in an industry of his desired specialization for 3-4 days in a week as a regular employee under the guidance of an internal guide from the institute & an external guide from the Industry .In this system he is able to apply class-room knowledge at his work place & can discuss work place situations with other students & can also seek solutions of the same with his/ her faculty. The net result is a perfect integration of class room learning with the work place performance leading to a roughly two years experience in case of Under Graduate Programmes & one year experience in case of Post Graduation Programmes. It is a win -win situation where a graduate or post graduate does not approach industry with only the degree or diploma but with relevant experience and not with the fresher tag. He\ She is also in a position to demand higher salaries than their traditional Management qualified colleagues that leads to faster growth and achievement of personal & organization objectives.

It is a win -win situation for organizations too as organization receives a management qualified trained & experienced candidate who needs lesser or almost negligible time to settle in the job & who would start giving output or contribution much faster or almost instantaneously thus achieving department & organization objectives.

Placements our prime objective

Training and Placement department is a mandatory requirement for any University Program. It acts as a link between the Institution and the Industry by creating a strong liaison with the Industry.

Functions of Training and Placement Department.

1. Provides insights to the Management, Faculty, Trainers and the students regarding the ever-changing requirements of the corporates.
2. Provides inputs to the Institution regarding the skill sets, recruitment methods being employed at various organizations.
3. Provides finishing training to the students as per Industry requirements.
4. Provides inputs to the Industry

The Placement department constitutes a Committee consisting of the Faculty, Students, and Staff & People from the industry.

Objective of this committee is to link the industry with the university and the students.

Students are groomed in the classroom in soft skills such as communication skills, language skills, reading, writing, & thinking skills.

Apart from the skills training special emphasis is given on the computer skill & personality development.

Interaction with the industry by inviting the industry personnel to provide inputs regarding industry needs, profile requirements, skills, required business practices etc.

Final placement activity starts with the preparation of Placement Brochure and major industrial & commercial cities are covered by personal meeting, telephonic and mail contact as well as through mailers.

Top of the industry is invited to inspect the facilities as well as to conduct the interviews by delivering pre placements talks leading to complete placement procedure of group discussion, aptitude tests, situation handling, and interviews leading to the final placement of the students.

Admission procedure

Application form

Candidates may apply on the pre printed form attached with the prospectus or may download from our website www.kalingauniversity.org or can be collected from the Reception by paying Rs. 500/- in cash or via demand draft in favor of Kalinga University payable at Raipur. Downloaded form will be accepted only with Rs. 500/- cash or demand draft as above mentioned.

Certificates

Application form must be attached with notarized or attested (from a Gazetted officer) photocopies of all eligibility certificates as given below:

- For Under Graduate Programmes Copy of X, XII Mark Cards & Migration Certificate/ Transfer Certificate.
- For Post-Graduate Programmes Copy of X , XII, Graduation Certificate (all 3 years Marksheets, Degree/Provisional Degree) & Migration Certificates.

Deposit of Fee

Selected candidates will have to deposit the fee within ten working days after the declaration of successful candidates list. In case the fee is not deposited in the stipulated time , the student's claim to the admission expires & the same will be passed on to the first waiting list candidates.

At the time of deposit of fees students need to deposit the original certificates with the Admission/ Administration department & collect the receipt of the same.

Enclosures to be attached with the filled in application forms:

- Self attested photocopies supporting academics and evidence of proof for employment. Self employed candidates must attach relevant document as proof of work experience for their organization.
- Candidates have to produce the originals of all documents at the time of personal interview as well as at the time of admission, if selected.

Academic Calendar

The academic calendar of the Kalinga University will be followed for all the academic and examination matters.

Discipline

The students of the programme will be governed by the University rules in regard to minimum attendance, evaluation for award of Degree Certificate .Student shall abide by the statutes ordinances, Rules, and Regulations of University that are in force from time to time .They shall give due respect to the teachers and staff of the University and shall display decent and cordial behavior to fellow students .

NOTE

The admission rules, including eligibility criteria, and procedures are subject to alteration at any time without notice. The decision of the Vice Chancellor in all matters relating to admission shall be final . Dispute, if any, will be subject to jurisdiction of Raipur courts only.

A candidate, who furnishes particulars which are found to be false or suppresses material information, will not be considered for admission. In such a case, notwithstanding Legal action under the law of the land, his/her admission shall be cancelled, and all fees deposited by him/her shall be forfeited.

Kalinga Scholarships

Merit and Other Scholarships (Academic Year 2016-17)

The above said scholarships have following given objectives:

1. To reward meritorious students based upon their performance in XII standard board examination.
This is termed as Merit Scholarship.
2. To reward those students who belong to the special category.

Following are the details of Merit Scholarship for undergraduate programs.

Merit Scholarships are based upon the aggregate percentage a student has scored in his XII standard examination.

Sr. No.	Aggregate Percentage Range scored in XII standard	Scholarship Percentage on Tuition Fee only
01	90% and Above	75%
02	Between 75% to 89%	50%
03	Between 60% to 74%	25%

Other Scholarships available for Undergraduate and Post Graduate programs:

1. There is a 25% scholarship on the tuition fee meant for wards (sons and daughters) of:
 - a) Serving and Retired Defence Personnel (Army, Navy and Air Force) ,
 - b) Paramilitary Forces (CRPF, CISF etc.)
 - c) State and Central Police.
 - d) Recipient of National / State Level Award Conferred by Government of India or State Government.
 - e) Recipient of an International Award Conferred by a Foreign Country.
 - f) SC, ST and OBC category students.
 - g) One of the Sibling.
2. There is a 50% Scholarship on the tuition fee available for the students falling in following category:
 - a) Girl Child.
 - b) Handicapped.
 - c) Sons and daughters of Martyred Defence, Paramilitary and Police Personnel.
 - d) Players who have participated in a National or International event.
 - e) Wards of Serving Kalinga University Staff.

Terms and Conditions:

1. This scholarship is applicable for the entire course duration.
2. Scholarship is applicable only on the tuition fee.
3. The student shall maintain minimum 75% attendance as per state rules.
4. A student can avail only one scholarship whichever is higher.
5. Once availed a student cannot change the category.
6. Number of scholarship seat in each category are limited and will be filled on First come First Serve basis.
7. The scholarship shall be immediately withdrawn if the student fails in any subject in any semester or year.
8. The scholarship shall be withdrawn if the recipient does not maintain decent code of conduct and is found to be indulged in ragging, eve teasing or any unlawful activity.
9. The scheme is applicable to Indian Nationals only.

Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 26th April, 2015
considered the above mentioned subject. After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations:-

The Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report submitted by the inspection team. After consideration, the Committee is of the view that School of Law, Kalinga University, Raipur, Chhattisgarh be granted three additional sections along with existing strength of two sections i.e. total five sections for imparting three year LL.B course from the academic year 2015-2016 subject to the condition that Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.

Institution should submit affidavit in compliance to the above conditions within six weeks.

However, so far faculty member for law at Sl. No.14, 15, 17, 19 and 20 are not qualified as they did not possess master degree in law. College to appoint qualified teachers in their places through regular selection within a period of three months under intimation to the Bar Council of India.

3. The college management is a Aid Centre as per Clause-11, Part-IV of the Legal Education Rules.
4. College should ensure the payment of Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV.
5. The institution is directed to upgrade minimum Rs.50,000/- per year.
6. Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India.
7. Institution should submit affidavit above conditions within three months.

The above recommendations were considered by the Committee at its meeting held on 9th May, 2014 and accepted.

The college shall also comply with the following of India (Clause (iii) and Explanation 2 of Schedule 2 of the Rules of the Bar Council of India):-

"Whenever approval of affiliation is granted, Legal Education, it shall be necessary to deposit Rupees 75,000/- as a guarantee to fulfil all the norms of the Bar Council of India. The same shall be liable to be forfeited if the institution fails to comply with and same shall carry no interest."

The approval of affiliation now granted by the Bar Council of India subject to the payment of guarantee amount as per the rules.

College authorities are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval of affiliation before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation by the Bar Council of India i.e. on or before 31st December, 2015. The fee will be charged.


